The Clinical Counsellor works in a team-based care model, providing support to Éyameth' Health Centre clients and programs in the North Fraser region. Support is provided through various modalities including 1-1 meetings, outreach services, and development and delivery of wellness and cultural programming. The Clinical Counsellor is a key resource and educator for internal and external partners with respect to community-driven health and wellness support and guidance.

Qualifications/ Requirements

1. Master's degree in clinical psychology (MACP), social work (MSW) or education (M Ed.)
 - a. An equivalent combination of education, training and demonstrated competency will be considered on a case-by-case basis
2. Current valid accreditation under a registered professional licencing body in British Columbia
3. Ensures Indigenous cultural values and philosophies are infused throughout their clinical work within the Éyameth' Health Centre
4. Demonstrated ability to maintain confidentiality as well as knowledge of how and when the bounds of confidentiality may be broken in relation to client safety
5. Knowledge of different therapeutic modalities such as IFOT, CBT, MI, DBT
6. Deep understanding and working knowledge of trauma, addiction, mental health, and their impact on behavior and whole person physical, cultural and spiritual wellness
7. Ability to work collaboratively with Éyameth' team and community and health partners with a client-centred approach and demonstration of strong active listening and communication skills
8. Demonstrated knowledge of all relevant legislation relating to this position and service delivery
9. Crisis intervention and case management experience would be an asset
10. Open to innovative therapeutic and wholistic wellness approaches, such as land and arts based
11. Understand and respond to complex family dynamics, including trauma, addiction, and mental health challenges in a culturally safe, and appropriate manner
